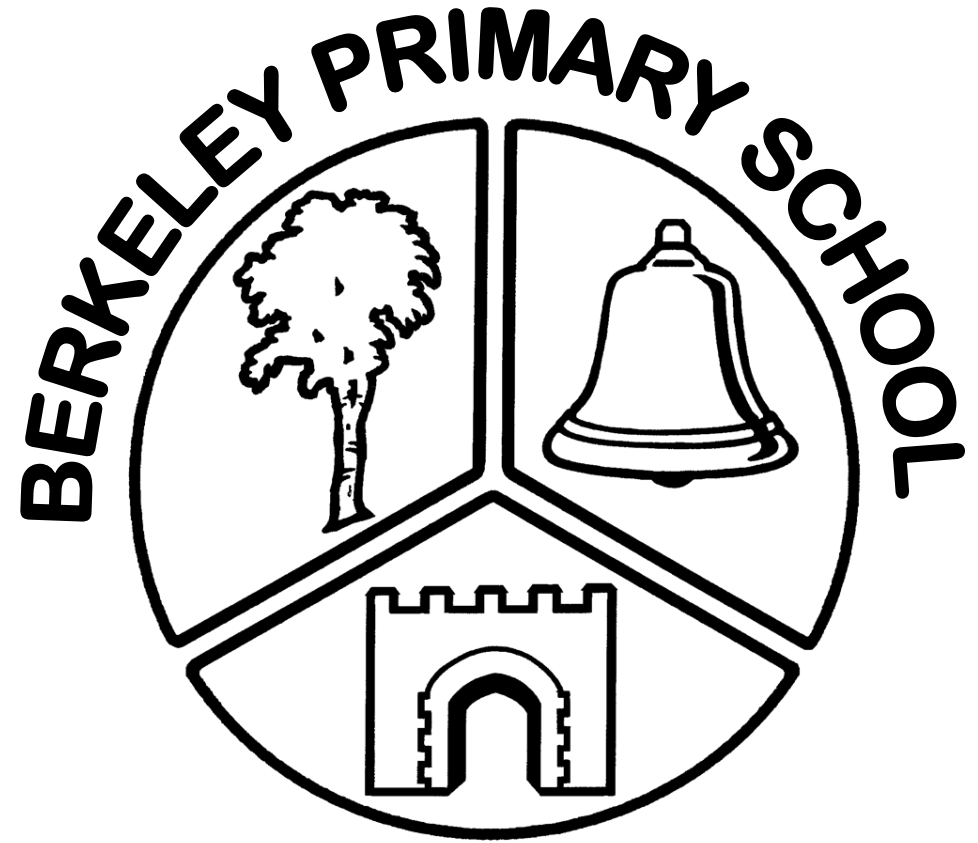

Information

Homework
