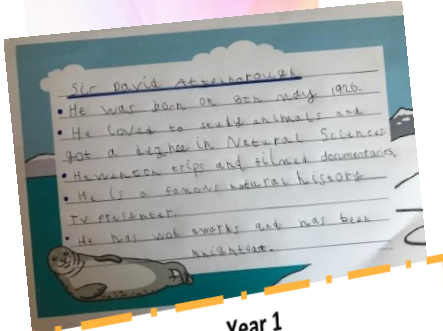
Reception

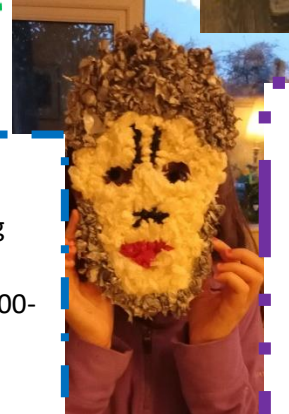
Year 4
