I know what opaque, transparent and translucent means.

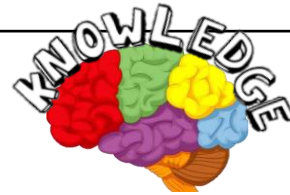
I know which materials are absorbent.
