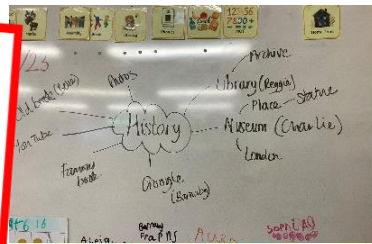
Year 1

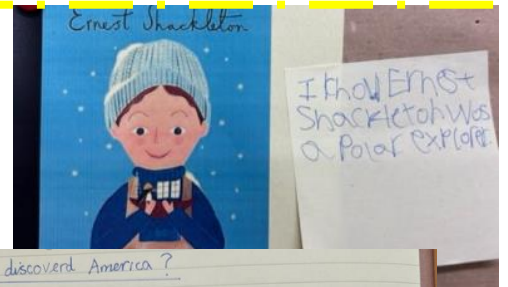
Reception

Year 2 have been learning about famous people and looking at how we make timelines. They looked at Ernest Shackleton and did a timeline of the great explorers life and achievements.

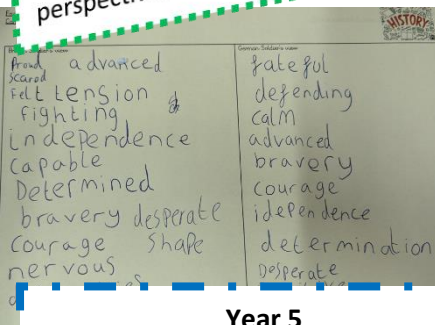
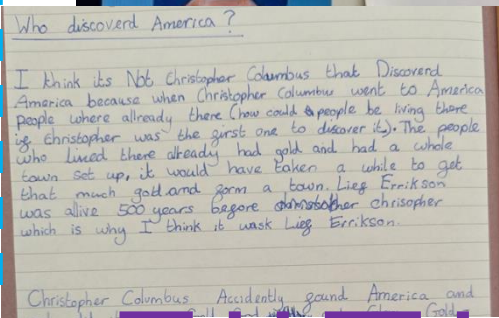


Year 4
