## WORLD WAR 1



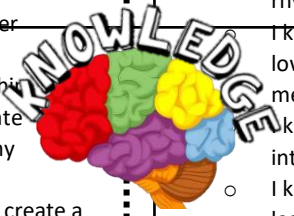
- I know which household devices and appliances can be plugged into the mains or run on batteries.
